

TENNESSEE QSO PARTY 2021



Activity in 2021 didn't quite meet our record-breaking numbers from last year. They were, however, better than any *other* previous year. We had 352 entries – not as many as the 415 we had in 2020, but far more than the 249 which was our previous best. 34,599 QSOs were reported – not as many as the 38,466 reported in 2020, but more than the previous best of 32,974. Last year, DX operators DL3DXX and OM2VL posted second- and third-place scores in their categories. This year, OM2VL squeaked out a first-place victory over WX4G. (and DL3DXX placed a very respectable 4th place. These entries represent magnificent efforts for overseas operators!)

All 50 states were worked, along with eight provinces of Canada and 51 DXCC entities on all continents. Entries were received from 41 states, eight provinces, and three DXCC entities. 86 of the 95 counties were worked, with entries received from 78.

65% of QSOs were made on 40 meters. 19% were on 80, and 14% on 20. Most of the remainder were on 160 and 15. Three operators made a total of 17 QSOs on 2 meters – in one case making a nice collection of additional multipliers.



QSOs by band






K3IE operating K4TCG at the phone position



N9GX shattered NE4TN's 2017 record. W9SN broke K4LTA's 10-year-old record. KC4NX beat his own 2020 record – but W4KW did even better. KX4CH is the first station to submit a high-power, mulitop, CW-only mobile entry. Blank spots in the table represent categories that have never seen an entry. Give one a try!

LOGCHECKING NOTES

The logcheckers would greatly appreciate it if entries were sent in Cabrillo format, preferably as an attachment. (*not* pasted into the body of an email) Please make sure your Cabrillo file contains an "ARRL-SECTION:" tag with a proper section. ("ARRL-SECTION: TN" for Tennessee stations. If you aren't sure what section you're in, enter your state abbreviation. It'll probably be right & if it isn't, we can easily fix it.)

We understand sending a Cabrillo file may not be possible for some entrants.

As a bare minimum, we need to know:

- The callsign you used during the contest!
- The callsigns of anyone else who operated your station during the contest.
- Your name & address.
- How much power you used 5 watts or less; between 6 and 100 watts; or more than 100 watts?
- Your location county, state, province, or DXCC Entity.
- And for each QSO:
 - Band
 - Mode
 - Date & time
 - Your location during the QSO, if it changes during the contest. (mobile/portable operation)
 - Call of the station worked
 - Location sent by the station you worked. (state/county/province/DXCC entity. If you work
 a DX station, enter the station's country *not* just "DX".)

It should be noted that ADIF files usually do *not* contain much of the necessary data.

We occasionally see files in which the location field contains much more data than we believe was transmitted over the air. (for example, the entire mailing address of the station worked) We suspect this information was filled in from QRZ.com or some other database. *This practice is regarded as unethical*. Many contests would disqualify these entries. Please ensure the location data in your log reflects what you received over the air. Note also that you can lose a LOT of points this way. Some of our most successful entrants operate portable or mobile – from locations different from that printed on their FCC license.

While the TNQP rules do not prohibit the use of the FT4 or FT8 modes, it is difficult to transmit the necessary exchange information. (and even more difficult to get the other station to transmit the necessary information) We had to disallow nearly all claimed FT8 QSOs this year as almost none of them contained the necessary exchange. TCG leadership is discussing whether to allow digital mode QSOs in the TNQP in the future.
