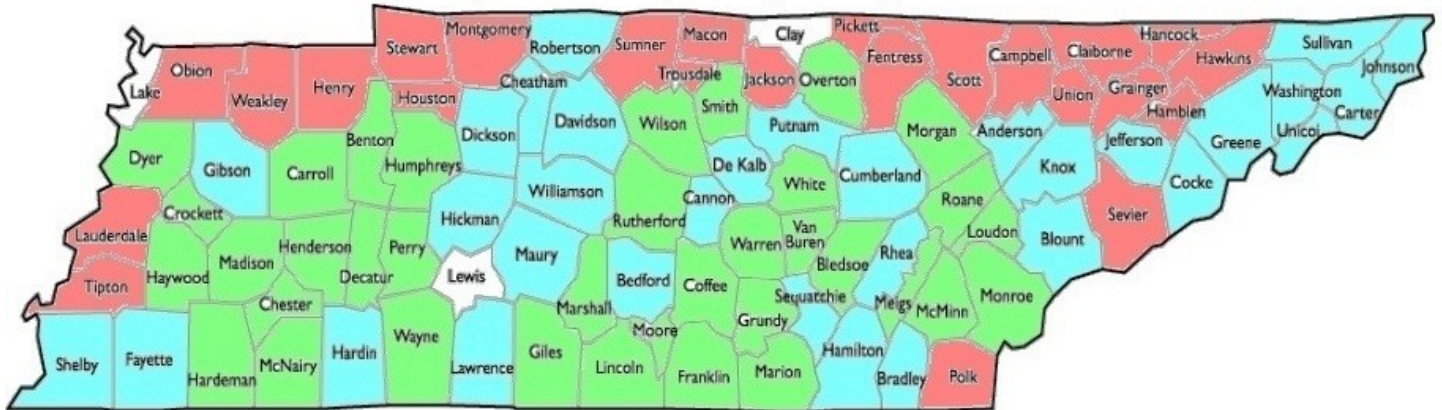




2025 Tennessee QSO Party Results

Tennessee Operations by County **Red-Fixed Only, Green-Mobile/Rover, Blue-Fixed+Mobile** **(White > No Reported Operations)**



The 2025 Tennessee QSO Party is now behind us! Contacts were recorded with 92 of our 95 counties so we're getting close to completing a sweep. The challenge is now official for Rovers/Mobiles next year - let's get those remaining 3 in the logs!

Les, VE3NNT led the pack with an outstanding total of 76 counties followed closely by Laci, OM2VL, with 74 and Freddie, AA3R, with 72. The top mobile station once again was Jim, AD4EB, partnering with Kirk, K4RO, - 1,784 Qs in 10 hours! Also of note was Andrew, AA5JF, who came from Georgia and operated in our relatively new ROVER category snagging 688 Qs. Nice going guys!

Our log count was down a bit from last year, 316 vs 347, but overall QSO count was up over 700 to 34,080. Steve, W9SN, struck gold again and set yet another SOLPFixedCW all time high score of 478,224, topping last year's record by almost 10,000 points. Don, N4ZZ, set a new SOHPFixedCW record at 361,446 and Andrew, AA5JF, set a new SOLRoverMixed target at 260,436. Last, but certainly not least, Laci, OM2VL, has set the new standard for Out-of-State records at 133,268! Congratulation to all.

New for this year, the K4TCG callsign emanated from WV4P's superstation in Hardin county. Not only did they mix remote and local ops but they also were testing the new TTS (Text to Speech) facility in N1MM. If you worked them on phone you talked to Amy! Even though they had a minor glitch on CW, they almost established a new record. Nice work Ron and crew!

This year's plaque winners are once again in the spotlight. Receiving one of Mark's (K0EJ) hand crafted plaques has to be the highlight of the year for these deserving hams! Congratulations and keep up the good work.

First time really trying to use antennas on the car to make State QSO party contacts -- in GA and SC parties this category requires truly portable antennas, which I only used at the first location. The mobile setup basically worked, but unfortunately spent precious time learning which antenna goes where and how, and I never was able to change bands quickly, which had been my intention. But when I finally figured out my mobile 80M antenna (with 90 minutes left to go), it turned out to work pretty well. Wish I had had it 2 hours earlier. Beautiful Sunday weather. My favorite spot was the SULL/JOHN county line, on the Appalachian Trail, trying to focus on the bands, while distracted by the unending numbers of motorcycle riders racing the mountain curves of "The Snake" on US-421.
AD4EB	This was the 13th time that an AD4EB mobile team has run in the TNQP. The team was comprised of Kirk, K4RO, and Jim, AD4EB. Don, N4ZZ, did not make it this year, and Melody was given a driving rest in preparation of the upcoming TXQP in 2 weeks. We drove thru 25 counties over the 381 mile loop in perfect weather, and everything went off without a hitch. The pileups were tough at times, but so much fun. Our goal was to beat last year's score, but we came up a hair short. Last year we had 8 more QSOs (1,793) and 2 more mults (154). Guess we will just have to try harder next year.
